3. Disposal of all waste/rubbish from the work premises on a daily basis until the completion of the project
4. Take out and dispose old carpet and underlay
5. Removal of furniture and return to designated area
6. Work area should be protected to prevent damage to the property, particularly the wall skirting, and to fix or replace skirting if necessary
7. Detailed installation work schedule and timeframe of completion
8. Mode of payment
