Vehicle Model 2023;
8-seater passenger van;
Engine displacement should not exceed 3000 cc for diesel; and
Engine should not exceed four (4) cylinders.

Interested suppliers/companies are requested to provide the following documents: i) Proof of Registration through a valid Australian Business Number (ABN); ii) License or permit to do business; iii) Statement of Compliance/Conformity with all the Technical Specifications; iv) Schedule of Requirements (Delivery Schedule); v) Financial Statements from the relevant Australian government authority for the preceding year; and vii) Performance Security or certification that performance security is not a business practice in Australia;
