

VISA-FREE PRIVILEGES FOR INDIAN NATIONALS ENTERING THE PHILIPPINES

- Indian nationals holding valid **American, Japanese, Australian, Canadian, Schengen, Singapore or United Kingdom (AJACSSUK) visas or residence permits** may enter without a visa for a **non-extendible period of 30 days for tourism or business**, upon presenting a passport valid for at least 6 months beyond the contemplated stay, and return ticket or onward ticket to another country.

Note: For a stay longer than thirty (30) days but not to exceed fifty nine (59) days for tourism or business they may apply for a visa at Foreign Service Posts (FSP) in India, any FSP in a country where the applicant has legal residence (example: ***Philippine Consulate General in Sydney for residents of NSW and New Caledonia***) through the <https://evisa.gov.ph/>.

- Indian nationals who are not holders of **American, Japanese, Australian, Canadian, Schengen, Singapore or United Kingdom (AJACSSUK) visas or residence** may enter Philippines without a visa for a non-extendible and non-convertible period of 14 days **for tourism or business**, upon presenting a passport valid for at least 6 months beyond the contemplated stay, confirmed hotel booking, proof of financial capacity, and return ticket or onward ticket to another country.

Note: For a stay longer than thirty (30) days, they may apply for a visa at their country of origin Foreign Service Posts (FSP) in India or any FSP in a country where the applicant has legal residence.

- All travellers must present an e-travel declaration to immigration counters upon arrival. You may apply up to 72 hours before arrival at <https://etravel.gov.ph>. **Registration is free.** Save the QR code for presentation at immigration counters.
